What needs to be prepared <u>prior</u> to kids' arrival: Regular classroom set up

Hook 5 minutes	Introduce street art and the value of the month and showcase known artists work. Explain what the activity is.	Student can help set up the room.	What is graffiti? What is a tag? How can we connect street art to freedom?
Graffiti 10 minutes	Students will sketch out, color in and cut out their graffiti art including their own tag.		What does freedom mean to you?
Debrief 5 minutes	Clean up, share what everyone made by taking turns.	Student can help clean up the room.	How have your friends interpreted the value of the month?
